FINAL ORDER


Val Jean F. Hillman (Respondent) having submitted a resignation under 37 C.F.R. § 10.133(b), and an affidavit in compliance with 37 C.F.R. § 10.133(c), on behalf of James E. Rogan, Under Secretary of Commerce For Intellectual Property and Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, it is:

1. ORDERED that Val Jean F. Hillman, of Schaumburg, Illinois, Registration Number 34,841, be excluded on consent;
2. ORDERED that the Director of Enrollment and Discipline (OED Director) publish the following notice in the Official Gazette:

NOTICE OF EXCLUSION ON CONSENT

Val Jean F. Hillman, of Schaumburg, Illinois, Registration No. 34,841, has been excluded on consent by the Director of the United States Patent and Trademark Office pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 32. This action is taken pursuant to 35 U.S.C. § 32, and 37 C.F.R. §§ 10.133(e), and 10.159(b).
