MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

On March 13, 2025, Applicant USA HAM LLC (“Applicant”), filed a request for an extension of time to seek judicial review of the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board’s January 17, 2025 final decision sustaining the opposition proceeding. The request seeks an extension to allow the Applicant and its counsel to fully consider its legal options. The request is GRANTED for the reasons below.

Under 37 C.F.R. § 2.145(e)(1)(i), the Director may, for good cause, extend the time to seek judicial review under 15 U.S.C. § 1071 of a Board decision if the request is made in writing before the period for seeking judicial review expires. Under 37 C.F.R. § 2.145(d)(1), the period for seeking judicial review expires sixty-three (63) days from the date of the final decision of the Board. The relevant period here runs from January 17, 2025, and therefore any request for extension of time is due on or before March 21, 2025. Because Applicant’s request for extension of time was filed on March 13, 2025, the request is timely and considered under the good cause standard.

The request explains that the primary language of Applicant’s decision makers is not English and that “Applicant and its counsel require additional time to discuss the complexity of the TTAB decision,” the appeal process, and “the legal options which may include engaging additional appellate counsel.” Based on the explanation, there is good cause for the requested forty-five (45) day extension.

Accordingly, the request for extension of time is GRANTED. Applicant has through and including May 5, 2025, to seek judicial review of the Board’s decision.
